Special Services/Events:

Palm Sunday (Sun 14 Apr 10.00)

This service marks the beginning of Holy Week and commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem with a donkey. A real donkey leads the procession.

Holy Week

Monday 15th April: Stations of the Cross (19.30):

The congregation journeys round the 14 stations of the cross, depicting Jesus' journey. There is a pause at each station with some words for reflection.

Tuesday 16th April: Tenebrae (20.00):

Tenebrae is Latin for shadows and this service recreates the emotional aspects of the passion story starting with a candlelit church and gradually extinguishing all but the Christ candle.

Wednesday 17th April: Compline and short reflection

(19.30): A service of night prayer with quietness and reflection.

Thursday 18th April: Maundy Thursday and The Watch

(19.30): This service commemorates the last supper which Jesus shared with his disciples before his crucifixion and where he washed the disciple's feet. The service ends with the church being made bare with the 'stripping of the altar'. Following on from the Service the Church is open for silent prayer to remember that Jesus asked his disciples to stay and pray with him.

Friday 19th April: An Hour at the Cross (14.00)

A Reflective Service of hymns, readings and prayers remembering Jesus' final hours and crucifixion.

Saturday 20th April: Easter Eve (19.30)

Service of Light

Sunday 21st April : Easter Day (10.00)

Easter Day service with a special Easter egg hunt for children and some animals to share the special day.

What Else?

For children:

Toddlers: a weekly fun get together for toddlers and their parent/carer (Thursday morning) during term time. On the 3rd Thursday of the month (usually), there is a Service in Church at 11am, lasting 15 minutes.

3rd@10 for children: a child friendly activity-based time for children of all ages in the church hall before joining at the service end (3rd Sunday of each month at 10am).

4th @ 4: For children of all ages and their parents-themed activities with food to share. (4th Sunday of each month at 4pm)

For everyone:

Morning prayer: 8.30am informal prayer 4 mornings a week in church

Healing service: a quiet reflective and moving monthly service (1st Thursday) that includes the laying on of hands and the recognition of God's sustaining presence in pain, sickness, injury and estrangement.

Wulfherans: adult mixed fellowship with a varied programme of meetings and entertainment.
